Regarding continuation of affiliation of Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Bolangir under Sambalpur University, Jyoti Vihar, Burla from the academic

Your office letter No.HE-UNE-UNI-0009-2022/37224/HE Dt.,06.09.2022 and Proceeding of this College Governing Body Meeting dated 10.02.2023(Copy Ref: enclosed).

In obedience to your office letter vide above reference, Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Bolangir is continuing its affiliation for both UG,PG & Ph.D. courses under Sambalpur University, Jyoti Vihar, Burla up to the year 2021-22.Meanwhile the students of both UG & PG courses have taken admission in this institution for the academic session 2022-23.It is learnt that, Odisha University of Health Science, Bhubaneswar will be functional very soon and this institution Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Bolangir will be affiliated under that Health Science University with immediate effect(Copy enclosed).

Hecne, it is requested to take necessary steps for continuation of affiliation of UG,PG & Ph.D. courses of this institution under Sambalpur University, Jyoti Vihar, Burla from the academic session 2022-23 onwards until affiliated under Odisha Health Science University as there shall be technical difficulties for the students in terms of Examination , Degree Certificates etc if de-affiliated from Sambalpur University, Jyoti Vihar, Burla to Rajendra University for a small period of time.

It is therefore humbly requested to grant affiliation to Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Bolangir from 2022-23 onwards to continue under Sambalpur University, Jyoti

Vihar, Burla until affiliated to Health Science University, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

At the outset, Vice-President of Governing Body of Govt.Ay.College,Bolangir welcome the President and members present in the meeting.Then he read the proceeding of the previous Governing Body meeting of the College before the members for kind approval and was unanimously approved.

Then, with the permission of the President, the Principal-cum-Vice President of Governing Body detailed the agenda before the Committee for discussion and resolved as follows:-

01. Diversion of drain & rain water of Maharanisagar entering to the College campus and renovation of existing drain.

Regarding entering of drain water inside the College campus, Principal informed that due to blockage of the existing outside drain adjacent to front boundary wall, the drain and rain water of Maharaniagar entering into the College throughout the year for which the hospital and hostel environment is being polluted due to water logging as a result of which students and patients are being affected with vector borne diseases and valuable medicinal plants of the herbal garden are destroyed. The matter was discussed and President instructed Tahasildar, Bolangir, Municipality representative and Asst. Executive Engineer(R&B) Bolangir to take immediate steps to block the entry of drain water inside the College and renovation of existing outside drain within 7 days.

02. Construction of over head water tank for Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital and SGAH, Bolangir.

As regards construction of one overhead water tank inside the College campus, it was revealed that PHD, Bolangir will execute the works where soil test for the purpose has been done. As the design/drawing of the overhead tank has not been prepared, the Executive Engineer, PHD, Bolangir has assured President, Governing Body & Hon'ble MLA, Bolangir to start the said work within one month.

#### 03. Construction of new Gent's Hostel and Ladies Hostel inside College campus.

The matter was discussed in front of the members. Principal informed that due to enhancement of intake capacity of BAMS students, there were difficulties for accommodation of students in the existing Gent's & Ladies hostel. As per the proposal of the Principal for construction of hostels, the Executive Engineer (R&B), Bolangir has submitted the plan & estimate for construction of one new 100 seated ladies hostel and 50 seated capacity of 2nd floor of Boy's hostel inside the campus. It was resolved to send these proposals immediately to the Director, AYUSH, Odisha& Health Family Welfare Dept for further course of action. It was also decided that Principal may appraise Collector Dist. Magistrate, Bolangir about the acute hostel problem of the students and request him to provide emergency funds for construction of hostel for the purpose.

## 04. Construction of Boundary Wall of SaradeswariGovt. Ayurvedic Hospital, Bolangir and Govt. Ayurvedic College, Bolangir.

Principal informed the president & members regarding un-authorised encroachment of the west & south side of Saradeswari Govt. Ay. Hospital, Bolangir by the local people for which several difficulties are being experienced for smooth management of the hospital work and there may be problem during construction of boundary wall at Saradeswari, Govt. Ayurvedic Hospital, Daily Market, Bolangir. The matter was discussed thoroughly and President instructed to Bolangir Municipality authority to demolish the un-authorised construction surrounding the hospital within one month for starting of construction of boundary wall. The boundary wall of Sardeswari Govt. Ayurvedic Hospital, Bolangir and Govt. Ayurvedic College, Bolangir will be done by R&B, Bolangir after placement of funds.

# 05.Land alienation of Saradeswari Govt.Ayurvedic Hospital and Govt.Ayuvrvedic College & Hospital, Bolangir.

The Principal conveyed the President regarding non alienation of land of the College area of 9.141 Acres and Saradeswari Govt. Ayurvedic Hospital, Daily Market, Bolangir area of 2.245 Acres of land. The recent development of the matter was also informed to the Committee members. Taking the urgencyof the matter both President & Hon'ble MLA, Bolangir instructed Principal to apply the Tahasildar, Bolangir for settlement of land of both places immediately and Tahasildar was requested to dispose the matter as soon as possible.

### 06.Street Light inside the College & Hospital premises.

Principal appraised the members, that existing street lights inside the College & Hospital campus are insufficient to enlight the campus for which students, staff and patients are facing difficulties at night. So he requested Hon'ble MLA to provide some more high max lights for lightning of both the campus. Hon'ble MLA agreed to provide same at the earliest.

### 07. Provision for installation of DG Set for power back-up at both hospitals.

Principal informed the members that difficulties are being experienced by the patients, hostel boarders & office staff during frequent power cut for which power back up to both the hospital & hostel is necessary and provision for installation of D.G.Set is required. After discussion it was revealed that Rs.22,50,000/-(Rupees twenty two lakh fifty thousand)Only fund has been sanctioned for installation of Solar System at Govt.AyurvedicCollege,Bolangir and Saradeswari Govt.AyurvedicHospital,Daily Market ,Bolangir for which the DG set may not be required for power back up. The installation of Solar System work can be started by R&B, Bolangir after placement of sanctioned funds.

### 08. Construction of Special cabins for patient care in the Hospital.

Principal conveyed the members that, some VIP patients and out of State patients are coming to the hospital for special therapies like Panchakarma, Kshyarasutra, Gynaecological & Paediatric diseases for which special cabins are required to be constructed in both hospitals. The matter was discussed and resolved that Principal may send required proposal to R&B, Bolangír for providing Plan & Estimate for the above purpose as early as possible.

#### 09. Construction of Drug Testing Laboratory and one Animal House for PG research works.

Principal appraised the members regarding requirement of one Drug Testing Laboratory and Animal House for PG research work of this institution as per NCISM norm and submitted one proposal for Plan & Estimate for construction of the same to the R&B,Bolangir. The matter was discussed and Asst. Executive Engineer(R&B) Bolangir is requested to prepare necessary Plan and Estimate for the purpose of construction work.

10. Any other matter, if any, with due permission of the Chair.

#### (a) Construction of Panchakarma Therapy Building.

Principal informed the house that, as per proposal with Plan & Estimate for construction of one Panchakarma therapy building amounting to Rs.96,51,000/-(Rupees ninety six lakh fifty one thousand)Only at Hospital of ,Govt.Ay.College,Bolangir,funds are sanctioned for the purpose.Hon'ble MLA proposed the house to make the construction work of Panchakarma therapy building at Saradeswari Govt.AyurvedicHospital,Bolangir for better benefit of the public.The matter was discussed and unanimously resolved that the said Panchakarma Therapy building may be constructed at Saradeswari Govt.AyurvedicHospital, Daily Market Bolangir. Accordingly Executive Engineer(R&B)Bolangir was instructed to prepare final plan and estimate by visiting the spot at Saradeswari Govt.Ay.Hospital, Bolangir and submit the detailed Plan &Final Estimate of all the sanctioned construction works within 7 (seven) days to the Principal for onward submission to the Director,AYUSH and Govt.,H&F.W.Deptt. positively.

### (b) Continuation of College affiliation under Sambalpur University, Jyoti Vihar, Burla.

Principal informed the members about the status of affiliation of Govt. Ayurvedic College, Bolangir under Sambalpur University that UG& PG students up-to admission batch 2021-22 can continue under Sambalpur University vide Higher Education, Govt. of Odisha letter No.37224/H dt.06.09.2022 after which permission is required for continuation of 2022-23 onwards admission batch students. As Odisha University of Health Science has not yet been functional, so the house resolved and allow Principal to request to the Higher Education Deptt, Govt. of Odisha, Bhubaneswar for extension of affiliation under Sambalpur University until new affiliation under Health Science University, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

(c) Registration of Hospital Society and implementation of user charges at Hospital.

Principal proposed the members that one hospital society as continuing at Gopabandhu Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Puri may be framed and registered at Govt. Ayurvedic College, Bolangir for providing better service to the patients and implementation of user charges from the Above Poverty Line(APL) patients for availing some specialised therapies in Panchakarma, Prasuti Roga , Ano-rectal diseases. The collected money to be utilised for the procurement of medicines for those therapies. Hon'ble MLA, Bolangir expressed that, the hospital patient attendance may be affected due to implementation of user charges for which this proposal was not accepted.

During discussion Principal appraised the members regarding shortage of Govt.supply Ayurvedic Medicines at both the hospital are not getting free medicines throughout the year for which patients are suffering a lot. He requested Hon'ble MLA to provide some special funds for preparation of Ayurvedic medicines in the State Ayurvedic Pharmacy, Bolangir for supply to both hospital for un-interrupted supply of the Ayurvedic Medicines throughout the year. Hon'ble MLA assured to provide funds for which Principal is requested to prepare one estimate of different Ayurvedic Medicines to be required for both hospital distribution among the needy patients.

At the end Prof(Dr).S.B.Nayak, HOD& I/c Officer College Hospital gave vote of thanks to the President, Vice President and all respected members present in the meeting and meeting was closed.
